### Ward Temple Night

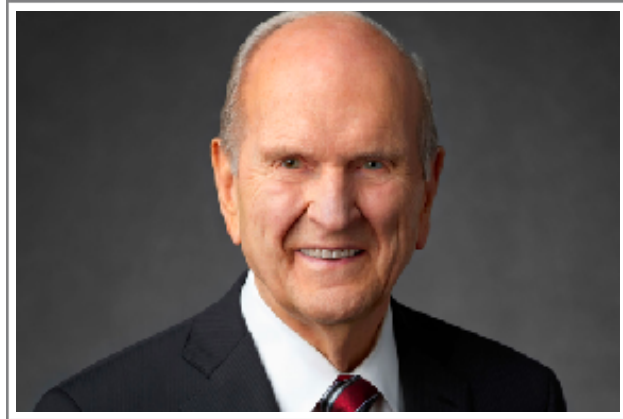
